REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

1. Age Requirement

- 18 Years or Older: Students must be at least 18 years old to enroll in our program independently.
- 17 Years with Parental Permission: Students who are 17 may be eligible to enroll with signed consent from a parent or legal guardian.

3. Valid Social Security Number (SSN)

A valid Social Security Number (SSN) is required to enroll in the program and to register for the Florida State CNA Certification Exam.

Your SSN is essential for verification and certification processes, ensuring compliance with state and federal regulations.

Additional Recommendations (Not Required):

- High School Diploma or GED: While not mandatory, having a high school diploma or equivalent is beneficial and preferred by some employers.
- Immunizations and TB Test: These are typically required for clinical placements. However, they are not required for enrollment.



PROGRAM PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

The Nursing Assisting program at Gabriel Health Institute requires students to meet essential cognitive, sensory, emotional, and motor performance standards. These standards ensure that students are prepared to perform the duties of a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) effectively and safely, with or without reasonable accommodations.

Applicants should use these standards as a guide to evaluate their ability to meet program requirements and assess whether accommodations may be necessary. Students with documented disabilities are encouraged to contact the appropriate resources to determine reasonable and appropriate accommodations on an individual basis.

Performance Standards

1. Critical Thinking

- Standard: Ability to handle multiple priorities, apply reasoning, and make sound decisions in a fast-paced environment.
- Examples of Activities:
 - Prioritize patient care tasks efficiently.
 - Recognize and respond to emergency situations promptly.

2. Interpersonal Skills

- Standard: Ability to display patience, empathy, and professionalism; maintain composure in challenging situations.
- Examples of Activities:
 - Communicate effectively with patients who may be fearful, confused, or hostile.
 - o Collaborate with healthcare teams in stressful environments.



3. Communication

- Standard: Ability to convey information clearly, accurately, and promptly in verbal and written forms.
- Examples of Activities:
 - Document patient care details accurately in records.
 - Explain procedures and provide instructions to patients and their families.

4. Mobility

- Standard: Physical ability to respond promptly to patient needs and maneuver in clinical settings.
- Examples of Activities:
 - Assist patients in moving, transferring, or positioning.
 - o Perform tasks requiring bending, squatting, kneeling, and reaching.
 - Walk or stand for extended periods.

5. Tactile and Motor Skills

- Standard: Sufficient manual dexterity and motor skills to handle equipment and provide safe patient care.
- Examples of Activities:
 - Perform tasks such as bathing, feeding, and dressing patients.
 - Use medical equipment, such as blood pressure cuffs and thermometers.
 - Perform fine motor tasks like taking vital signs or administering basic care.



6. Hearing

- Standard: Auditory ability to monitor and assess health needs with or without assistive devices.
- Examples of Activities:
 - Hear and respond to patient calls or alarms.
 - Listen to instructions and health concerns communicated by patients or team members.

7. Visual

- Standard: Visual ability to observe and assess patients and monitor equipment effectively, with or without assistive devices.
- Examples of Activities:
 - Observe changes in patient conditions, such as skin color or behavior.
 - Monitor medical equipment displays and patient vitals.
